



Seasons

LOW WATER SEASON

June to November. At this time the climate is drier and the low water levels attract creatures that can hardly be seen in the rainy season. The water level of the rivers falls during this period, exposing surprising sandy beaches. An ideal time to stroll through the forest and discover the Amazonian flora and fauna. Ideal for travelers who want to discover the Amazon's flora and fauna by walking through the rainforest.

HIGH WATER SEASON

December to May. This time of year is marked by rains and storms. It is in these months when most plants bloom or bear fruit, creating a unique show. Birds and primates are attracted by this spectacle and can be seen on the banks of the river. Ideal for travelers who prefer exploring the Amazon and its tributaries by boat rather than walking.

Amazon Conservation

Tourism has an enormous transformative power over regions and cultures, making this transformation positive and respectful of the lands and the people who inhabit them is our responsibility and for this reason we are deeply committed to protecting the ecosystem and its people.

In our commitment to a sustainable and responsible management of tourism, we are constantly working with local communities, visiting them with nonperishable food, provisions, clothes, and shoes.

We take advantage of these visits to teach children about environmental conservation, this activity is carried out to raise awareness and sensitize the community about the importance of protecting and preserving our environment and natural resources.

We also work with artisan women from the San Francisco community, on the Ucayali River. The artwork of these talented women is displayed on the ship as part of the decoration and we encourage tourists to purchase these artistic pieces and thus contribute to this community.

In addition to our efforts for the conservation of the Amazon and its resources, we are now partners and actively collaborate with **Amazon Forever** and **Amazon Forever BioPark**, a non-profit organization that promotes the conservation of white sand forests and other Amazon ecosystems through positive contact with nature, education, research, and the preservation of wildlife.

Another important contribution is our support for the Association for the Conservation of Amazonian Biodiversity (ACOBIA); where we collaborate with a donation for the execution of their activities.

Our guides have a relationship of more than 20 years with the Peruvian Amazon and they will lead you to a unique connection with all forms of life and cultures that give a meaningful shape to a region that breathes life.

Our official languages on board are Spanish and English. It is possible to provide guide service in French or German language.






Deck Plan



BOOKING POLICY

- For all registered travel agents, we offer the benefit of holding tentative departures without prepayment for a maximum of 7 days. Exclusive benefit only for FITS reservations.
- For Confirmed Bookings: A deposit of US\$ 500 per person is required to confirm the booking. For reservations made 90 days or less prior to departure, a full, non- refundable payment is required to confirm the booking.

FITS RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS

- Reservations made 90 days or less prior to departure: A full, non-refundable payment is required to confirm the booking.
- Reservations made 91 days or more before departure: A deposit of US\$ 500 per person is required to confirm the booking. The final balance is required 90 days prior to departure. If the payment is not received on time, the space(s) will be automatically released.

GROUP RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS (8 PAX OR MORE)

For Reservations made 121 days or more prior to departure:

- An initial deposit of US\$ 500 per person is required to confirm the booking, with a second deposit of US\$ 500 per person 120 days before departure. The final balance is required 90 days prior to departure.
- For Reservations made 120 days to 91 days prior to departure: A deposit of US\$ 1,000 per person is required to confirm the booking. The final balance is required 90 days prior to departure.
- For Reservations made 90 days or less prior to departure: A full, non-refundable payment is required to confirm the booking.

CANCELATION POLICY

For Cancelations made 121 days or more prior to departure:

- The deposit will be refunded, minus US \$200 service charge per person.
- For Cancelations made 120 to 91 days prior to departure: All deposits are non-refundable.
- For Cancelations made 90 days or less prior to departure: Full payment will be applied as the cancelation penalty.

In the following case of "Force Majeure", Jungle Experiences can reschedule the trip at no additional cost:

- Events that directly affect the operation of the cruises and prevent sailing, for example:
- An outbreak of infectious or contagious diseases/virus deemed a global epidemic or pandemic by the World Health Organization
- Events of political unrest and social manifestations.

DEPARTURE DATE CHANGE POLICY

- Jungle Experiences permits guests to change the departure date of their cruise at least 181 days prior to their original date of departure without penalty.
- A fee of US\$500 per person will be applied for date changes made between 180 and 121 days prior to departure. No date changes are permitted within 120 days from departure.

NAME CHANGE POLICY

- Jungle Experiences permits guests to change their names to other travelers' names up to 60 days prior departure date, without penalty.
- In case there is a change of name requested 59 days or less prior departure date, there will be a USD 200 penalty charge per person.

VESSEL REPLACEMENT POLICY

• Jungle Experiences reserves the right to substitute another vessel if considered necessary (i.e force majeure or mechanical failure). If the travelers do not take this option, Jungle Experiences reserves the right to cancel the trip upon a refund pro rata per cruise night not used or, as an alternative, will offer credit toward a future cruise.
